## 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Chronic overexposure to isocyanates has been reported to cause lung damage. Dryness of nasal passages, sore throat, cough, tightness of chest, shortness of breath. Persons suffering from allergic reactions to isocyanates should avoid contact with the product. This product may cause sensitization by inhalation and skin contact. Reports have associated repeated and prolonged overexposure to solvents with permanent brain and nervous system damage. May cause respiratory tract irritation.
